

UL Warns of Outdoor Lighted Sculptures with Unauthorized UL Marks for Canada

NORTHBROOK, Ill., Dec. 17, 2010: Underwriters Laboratories (UL) is notifying consumers and retailers that outdoor lighted sculptures sold in Canada and that were manufactured by Nixan International Ltd. were labeled by the manufacturer with unauthorized UL Marks for use in Canada. This notice does not include product sold in the United States. These sculptures have not been evaluated by UL to Canadian safety requirements and are not authorized to bear the UL Mark. It is unknown if this product complies with Canadian safety requirements.
