GLOSSARY OF TERMS

ELECTRICITY: This is the cost of electricity supplied to you during this billing period and is the part of the bill that is subject to competition.

DELIVERY: These are the costs of delivering electricity from generating stations across the Province to Halton Hills Hydro and then to your home or business. This includes the costs to build and maintain the transmission and distribution lines, towers and poles and operate provincial and local electricity systems. A portion of these charges are fixed and do not change from month to month. The rest are variable and increase or decrease depending on the amount of electricity that you use. The delivery charge also includes costs relating to electricity lost through distributing electricity to your home or business.* Halton Hills Hydro collects this money and pays this amount directly to our suppliers.

*When electricity is delivered over a power line, it is normal for a small amount of power to be consumed or lost as heat. Equipment, such as wires and transformers, consumes power before it gets to your home or business.

REGULATORY CHARGES: Regulatory charges are the costs of administering the wholesale electricity system and maintaining the reliability of the provincial grid.

GLOBAL ADJUSTMENT: Generators in Ontario receive a combination of payments from the operation of the wholesale market, payments set by regulation and payments under contracts. Your portion of the net adjustments arising from these and other authorized payments is included on your bill as the Global Adjustment.

PRE-AUTHORIZED PAYMENT: Payments automatically debited from your bank account on the due date.

ARREARS: Current bills are due and payable in full by the due date shown. "Due Date" refers to the current bill only. Items appearing as a "Balance Forward" are due immediately and are subject to collections.

Overdue interest will be applied to unpaid balances on hydro charges at a rate of 1.5% compounded monthly or 19.56% per annum. Interest on water is 2.0% compounded monthly.




