- Administer full-cycle payroll for HHH and affiliate company employees and Board members, including statutory deductions, OMERS pension, group benefits, and union dues.
- Maintain accurate payroll records and respond to inquiries regarding pay, benefits, pension, vacation, and statutory leaves.
- Prepare and reconcile journal entries, payroll-related general ledger accounts, ROEs, and year-end reporting.
- Assist with WSIB filings, LTD applications, and time entry validations including labour and truck time corrections.
- Support data collection and reporting for HR and labour relations purposes, including costing for collective bargaining and grievances.
- Assist with internal/external audits and compliance-related reporting.
- Prepare Statistics Canada reports and support regulatory filings (e.g. Cost of Service Applications).
- Contribute to annual labour budget projections for payroll and benefits.
- Provide cross-functional support for the Accounting team, as required.
